It also offers the opportunity to showcase your research to a broad range of the corn industry-from producers to end users. Additionally, there are a number of representatives of organizations that fund research at the conference.

To support and to encourage new researchers, the National Corn Growers association (NCGA) is pleased to present the Corn Utilization and Technology Conference Outstanding Poster Award.

Evaluation Criteria for Posters:

- Open to graduate students
- Relevance to the corn growing and dry grind processing/wet milling industries
- Aflatoxin/Mycotoxin reduction/elimination research during crop production, storage and processing
- Scientific originality
- Valid and supportable conclusions
- Oral and visual presentation
- To be eligible for student poster awards, student must be available to answer questions on the presented materials and be registered for CUTC.

Posters will be judged throughout the conference by a committee composed of personnel from various corn processing industries, academics and government scientists. Awards will be made to the top three student posters! The mycotoxin posters will be judged separately and awards will be made to the top three student mycotoxin posters as well!
